God is a just Judge (Psalms 7:11)

We don't mind the Justice of God so much. It comes in handy when evil is present. We take comfort in the fact that one day God will judge the world in righteousness. Yet, when it comes to our personal sins, we don't want justice but mercy. So we have a dilemma. How can a holy righteous God be merciful and gracious and still be a just Judge? For example, I appealed my parking ticket. I never saw the sign, though it was clearly marked had I looked up. I appealed for leniency or forgiveness being it a first time infraction. I asked for mercy. The Judge was just. So too, we cannot claim ignorance to God's moral law written in our heart. God's moral law are clearly marked in our hearts via our conscience. The only way I can be free from the Law is if I paid the fine or if someone else paid the fine for me. We owe a fine we cannot possibly pay but God in His mercy sent His Son Jesus Christ to pay our fine for us to set us free from the demands of the Law. We did the crime, Jesus paid our fine in His life's blood. He redeemed us from the curse of the Law having become a curse for us. We can refuse that gift but why would we do that? If we acknowledge our guilt, repent and trust in Christ God will forgive us our sins and grant us everlasting life.
