

Your words were found, and late them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16) God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble. (Psalm 46:1).

What is God like? The verse tells us three things about God and all of them relate to how we can relate to God in times of trouble. First, it tells us that God is our refuge. A refuge is a place of safety, a place of shelter. When trouble arises, who or what do you turn to? When a storm arises, you seek refuge, you seek shelter. In times of trouble, we are told to make God our refuge, our shelter (Psalms 61:3). The Eternal God is our refuge and underneath are the everlasting arms. Second, we are told that God is our strength. When trouble arises, where do we find our strength to endure? Paul found his strength in Jesus Christ through His grace. When we are weak He is strong. His strength is made perfect in our weakness. We can do all things through Christ who strengthens us. God says, "Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength" (Jer. 17:5). Lastly, He is our ever present help. When Peter began to sink, he said, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus caught him. When you are sinking, God is there to catch you, to help you, to strengthen you, to uphold you. God says, "Fear not, for I am with you." All you need is to cry out to Him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

"Now therefore, we are all present before God, to hear all the things commanded you by God." - Acts 10:33 To avoid distracting others please turn off cell phones and beepers before the service begins.
