Both Nehemiah and Ezra gave glory to the good hand of God that was upon them.. God was working all circumstances together in such a way, that it could only be attributed to the work of God. In the New Testament, we have another well known phrase which carries the same meaning, "God works all things together for good, for those that love God and are called according to His purpose." With regards to the hand of God, sometimes it mentions that the hand of God as mighty - powerful, or heavy, as in judgment. In Ezra, we read, "The hand of our God is for good on all who seek him, and the power of his wrath is against all who forsake Him" (Ezra 8:22) In His love for Jerusalem, "Behold, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands" (Isa. 49:16). So too, Christian, God has engraved you in the palm of His hands. How much do I love you? Look at the palms of my hand where I was nailed upon a Cross for you. Every time Jesus looks at the wounds He received in the house of His friends, He remembers you. God's right hand upholds you (Isa 41:13). You're in good hands with God. Underneath are the everlasting arms and that is where you are right now in Christ. The good hand of God is upon you.
