Your words were found, and | ate them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (2 Cor. 5:17)

It is interesting to note, that when you start with Christmas day, to the New Year, it is exactly eight days. Eight is a very significant number in the Scriptures. It is the number of new beginning. Seven days in a week, eight starts a new week. Seven notes on a scale, the eighth begins a new octave. The eighth day was the day that a child would be circumcised according to Jewish Law. Incidentally, the eighth day was the optimum day for this procedure to be done, the highest amount of prothrombrin, a blood clotting agent. So too, we have been circumcised with the circumcision made without hands. The seventh day is Saturday, the new beginning begins on the eighth day, Sunday. So too, Christ rose on the first day of the week. He finished the work of redemption, died (rested), and rose again on the first day of the week, the eighth day. There is an early teaching by many church fathers that the Millennial reign of Christ would be the seventh millennium with the New Heavens and New Earth signifying the Eighth Millennium. In Christ, God does not judge you of your past, He credits your future.
