Your words were found, and I ate them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16)

Oh wretched man that I am, who shall deliver me from this body of sin and death? (Romans 7:24)

We know before Paul was converted, he was a Pharisee. He was blameless as touching the righteousness which comes through the Law. So how did Paul go from "Law Keeping Superstar" to "Oh wretched man that I am" status? He became born again. The closer our walk with the Lord, the more we recognize our sin. Paul's only hope and ours is Jesus Christ and His righteousness. Isaiah when he saw Christ's Glory became undone. He said, Woe is me! I am undone! I am a man of unclean lips and I dwell with a people of unclean lips. Paul saw himself, sin and the Law in its true light and so sin, any sin, became exceedingly grievous. Romans 8 is his glorious hope: the glorious truth that his standing is not in the righteousness of the Law, but the righteousness of God through faith in Christ. Romans 6-8 forms one continuous thought with Romans 8 becoming the crescendo, Paul's magnum opus as it were. He grieved that he once persecuted the Church of God that he now belonged to. Yet he brought to mind, "Therefore there is now no condemnation in Christ Jesus." Halallelujah!
