The priest shall pronounce him clean (Leviticus 13:23)

According to the law of leprosy, it was required of anyone who has a leprous sore, or skin disease to be brought to the High Priest or one of the priests who served in the tabernacle. The High Priest would examine him closely and on the basis of examination would pronounce that person clean or unclean. Here we have a wonderful picture of redemption. Jesus is our High Priest (Heb. 8:1) and we too are closely examined—nothing escapes His notice. Leprosy in the Bible is a picture or type of sin. Just as leprosy kills the nerve endings of the leper, so too, sin kills the nerve endings of our conscience, searing it as a hot iron cutting off our awareness to the danger. Just as leprosy was incurable, and still is, so is sin. Yet, like leprosy, there is provided a supernatural healing of our condition. God, in His great love for us sent His Son, Jesus Christ to provide that healing. "For He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities, the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed. While we were yet sinners, God demonstrated His love for us on the Cross and, just like the leper, pronounces us clean in His eyes.
