Good and faithful servant. Are we good or faithful? We are at best unprofitable. Why would God call us what we are not? Answer: We are hid in Christ. The life we live, we live by faith in the Son of God. God doesn't see us in our own righteousness but in Christ's. Christ is that good and faithful servant. Who being in the form of God thought it not robbery to be equal with God but made Himself of no reputation and taking upon Himself the form of a servant and coming in the likeness of men and being found in appearance of a man He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Jesus could say, I *always* do those things that please the Father. Christ did for thirty three years what we could not do for thirty three seconds, and that is to keep the Law perfectly.
