Your words were found, and | ate them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16) Beware of false prophets (Matt. 7:15-16a)

Jesus never says anything we don't need to take serious consideration. When Jesus says beware, we should beware. What was it that we are to be alert of? He said, Beware of false prophets. What was a prophet? A prophet was one whom God sent to give a message to His people, Israel. What was the message that the prophets of God consisted of? It was always a message of a return to the true worship of God, repentance from ungodly living and idolatry. What was the message of false prophets? Generally, one of peace and prosperity. The didn't call out sin as Jerimiah wrote in Lamentations, "They have not uncovered (exposed) your iniquity" (Lam. 2:14). They are also well spoken of. Jesus said, Woe to you when all men speak well of you, for so did their fathers to the false prophets. Watch out for their words and their message —much like a campaign speech. "For when they speak great swelling words of emptiness. (2 Peter 2:18). Lastly, beware of the carrot they dangle at the end. Beware, they are among you.
