Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, "You Are the God Who Sees; for she said, "Have I also here seen Him who sees Me?" (Genesis 16:13).

Names in the Bible often were connected to significant events surrounding the naming of that person or place. Jacob was named as such because he caught the heel of his brother at birth. Thus he was named Jacob, which means Heel Catcher. God later changed his name from Heel Catcher to Israel, which means Man Governed by God. Some commentators see the Gospel laid out in Genesis 5 by taking the meaning of the names in the Genealogy of Adam in order from Adam to Noah. Here too, we see in Genesis 16 significant meaning in three names in this account, namely, Lahai Roi (The God who Sees) Ishmael (The God who Hears) and Hagar (One that Fears). Hagar which means Fearful had a conversation with The One who Sees who blessed her son and names him God who Hears. Christian, when you are fearful or in distress, remember you are in relationship with The God who hears you and see you and is faithful to deliver you from all your fears. He is faithful who promised.
