Not by works of righteousness which we have done but by His mercy He has saved us (Titus 3:5)

This verse can be construed as a real letdown to some. The thought that any good works, religious deeds, or cleaning up one's life does nothing to contribute to one's salvation goes against our concept of rewards and punishments. If you do good, you're rewarded. If you do bad, you're punished. This is generally true, but that is not the basis by which God saves us. Besides, the Bible tells us that we are all like an unclean thing and all our righteousness is like filthy rags. The filth mentioned is all our sins which stain our righteous deeds. In cancels our good deeds and renders them worthless. Just like making an omelet with five good eggs and one bad one renders the omelet inedible. A little sin, a little leaven leavens the whole lump. The good news is that neither our bad deeds will disqualify you from the mercy of God! God demonstrated His own love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. Jesus said he who come to me, I will in no wise cast out. Ever. Just as Moses was hidden in the Rock, so too, we are hidden in the Rock, the Rock which is Christ (I Cor 10:4).
