Your words were found, and | ate them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16) For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified. (Hebrews 10:14)

Jesus got the job done. Christ suffered once (not many times) for sins. The Just for the Unjust . In verse 10 it says By that (one sacrifice) will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. Notice the words are in the past tense? Perfected, suffered, been sanctified? The last words of Jesus in the Cross was Tetelestai, which means, It is finished, paid in full. He has taken the handwriting of ordinances which were against us which were contrary to us and he has taken it out of the way having nailed it to his cross having forgiven us all trespasses and sins. How many is left over after all? Romans 8 29-30, Paul writes, For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified. Again, notice the words in the past tense: foreknew, predestined, called, justified, glorified. He calls those things which are not as though they are. He who began a good work will be faithful to complete it. You're as good as done.
