"Be anxious for nothing but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be make known to God.

All of us have felt anxious at one time or another and people often treat it in the wrong way—through pills, booze, or other destructive behaviors. Fortunately the Lord has prescribed a safer, more effective treatment to anxiety or worry. It's called Prayer. Prayer is the air the Christian breathes. As the atmospheric pressure is greater outside than the air pressure in the lungs, it causes the lungs to inflate. So too, when outward pressure exerts itself upon the Christian, our reaction is to fill our lungs with prayer towards God. The Psalmist says "Cast all your cares on Him for He cares for you." Elsewhere the Psalmist says, "Pour your heart out to the Lord, for He is a refuge for us" (Psa 62:8). Why with thanksgiving? Thanksgiving because we have a God who gave us the ultimate sacrifice of His Son for our sins. He who spared not His own Son but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him freely give us all things? Who's got your back? None other but God Himself.
