Your words were found, and I ate them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16)

As many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are the sons of God (Romans 8:14)

I remember being asked that question: "Are you led by the Spirit of God?" Does God lead you? That's a good test. Jesus said My sheep hear my voice and I know them, and they follow me (John 10:27). Being led indicates a willing to be led. Jesus continues and says not only do they hear His voice, but they know His voice. Samuel did not know the Lord when he first heard His voice (I Sam 3:7) but later on he came to know His voice. Knowing God's voice indicates relation. Do you see the progression? First, hearing, then knowing, finally following, being led. With regards to being led, God says, do not be like a horse or like the mule which have no understanding, which must be harnessed with bit and bridle, else they will not come near you (Psa 32:9). God will if He needs to, use stronger measures to lead you but would much rather guide you by His voice and His eye. In the previous verse, He says, I will instruct you, and teach you in the ways you should go; I will guide you with my eye (Psa 32:8). In order for one to be guided by the eye means one is attentive, watching, waiting for further instructions. Are you being led?
