Your words were found, and I ate them. And your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart (Jeremiah 15:16)

No one is Holy like the Lord, for there is none besides you, nor is there any Rock like our God (1 Samuel 2:2)

Did you catch that? No one is Holy like the Lord. There is none besides Him. When we speak of holiness as it pertains to God, we are speaking of God's character, His nature, who He is. He is intrinsically Holy. In the prayer taught by Jesus to His disciples, He starts off with the most important thing—God's holiness. Our Father who is in Heaven, Holy is your Name. When God declares His name to Moses, He was describing who He is —merciful, gracious, longsuffering, abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity, transgression and sin. In Isaiah 6, we read the angels proclaiming, Holy Holy Holy is the Lord of Hosts! By the way, John attributes this to none other than our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ whom Isaiah wrote when he saw His Glory and spoke of Him (John 12:41). We are told also to live holy in light of His holiness. Trouble is, our own righteousness is like filthy rags before Him. Every time a saint encounters His holiness, their natural response is "woe is me! I am undone!" So too that should be our response as well. Yet, praise God, He is pleased, through the Gospel to impart, to impute to us His righteousness, His Holiness through faith in His Son, Jesus Christ. Hallelujah.
