

Also for Adam and his wife the LORD God made tunics of skin and clothed them (Genesis 3:21)

It is interesting to note the progression. In Genesis 2:25 we read, "And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed. Later, after disobeying the command of God not to eat of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, it says, "Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings (Gen. 3:7). Lastly, we see this verse where God replaced the covering they made for themselves and clothed them Himself. They went from pure, sincere relationship before God to self-imposed religion and finally, the promise of redemption (without the shedding of innocent blood there is no redemption). Now the Bible doesn't tell us what animal was used for the creation of the tunics made but I believe it was a lamb, which would be in keeping with the Biblical narrative. Notice the fig leaves of self imposed religious covering were insufficient. Our own righteousness is like filthy rags (Isa 64). Yet Jesus, the Lamb of God, clothed in human flesh, was sacrificed for us so that we might be covered with the righteousness of God in Christ. Now God no longer sees us in the human fig leaves of righteousness but in the pure, spotless linen of righteousness which is given to us through faith in Christ.

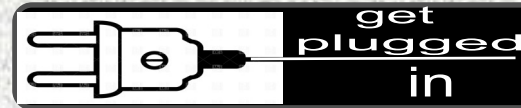
