
not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another— (Hebrews 9:25)

The High Priest could only go into the Holy of Holies once a year to offer atonement for Israel with the blood of bulls and goats both for himself and for the sins of the people, yet Christ offered a much better sacrifice when He Himself offered His own blood once for all . One of my favorite words in the New Testament is the word. Tetelestai. That was the last word uttered by Jesus Christ on the Cross. That word means, It is finished, paid in full. Through His one sacrifice He has accomplished atonement for sin, once for all, having obtained eternal redemption (Heb. 9:12). I'm so glad He said It is finished. As far as the East is to the West, so far has He removed our sins from us. He has cast all our sins into the depths of the sea (Micah 7:19) and set up a sign saying No Fishing Allowed! He has wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross having forgiven us all trespasses and sin. How many of your sins were still yet future when Christ died on the Cross? Answer: all of them !!! Scripture tells us, "But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed." Jesus paid it all, all to Him I owe. Sin has left a crimson stain, He washed it white as snow. Praise God for His Sacrifice for you and for me.
