
If we walk in the light as He is in the light we have fellowship with one another...(I John 1:7)

In this verse we find two relationships in view. First, our relationship, fellowship, communion with one another, and secondly our fellowship, communion, relationship with God through Jesus Christ. God has called us to love one another, to serve one another, to be kindly affectionate, to be of the same mind. How do we achieve this "one-anotherness"? It's all tied into our walk with the Lord and our love for Him. Jesus said If you love me you will keep my commandments. What are His commandments? Yup, you guessed it: to love one another. 1 John 2:10 tells us, "He who loves his brother abides in the light and there is no cause for stumbling in Him. Conversely, he who says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness until now (v. 9). So part of walking in the light is loving one another, serving one another, to be kindly affectionate, to be of the same mind. He who professes but does not possess is one who walks in darkness. Does that mean we chuck doctrine to the wind in the name of love as some people today are doing? No, Paul writes that He [Jesus] gave some to be apostles, prophets, evangelists , pastors and teachers. Why? To equip us for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and the knowledge of the Son of God. Loving one another and growing in Christ together with our brethren is the surest road to unity.
