Fruit. The deepest Christian desire is to bear fruit to God, abounding in the fruit of the Spirit—love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Who doesn't want that? It's interesting that the amount of fruit we produce is dependent upon how deep our roots go. In Psalm one we read the one who walks with the Lord and does not ascribe to the worldly wisdom of this age but instead digs deep into the word of God and meditates on it day and night shall be like a tree, planted by the rivers of water that bring forth fruit in its season. Their leaf also will not wither and whatever he does shall prosper. Jesus talked about the four soils of a man's heart and spoke of the one who's heart was described as stony ground. They looked good for a while, looked like an on-fire Christian, but fell away because they had no depth of earth, they had no root system to speak of so when trials and tribulation came, they were scorched and withered away because they had no root. But not so with the Christian. Our root system is none other than the Lord Jesus Christ and we abide in Him. He who abides in Him bears fruit, good fruit, much fruit. You see, our root system is not in ourselves. We are branches abiding in the Vine. Are you bearing good fruit? If not, check your root. Abide in Christ. Meditate. Saturate yourself in the Word of God and of Christ and you will bear good fruit.
