

And the posts of the door was shaken... (Isaiah 6:4)

What a sight it must have been for Isaiah the Prophet. Notice the sequence of events. First, he sees the vision of God as King of Kings and Lord of Lords, high and lifted up in all His holiness and majesty. Then he hears the angelic beings proclaim His holiness; the result being a shaking, a quaking of the very foundations—and the posts of the door was shaken. Next, Isaiah receives a revelation of himself in light of God's righteousness. He says, Woah is me, I am undone! Before we go any further in the LORD, we must see ourselves as undone, that our own righteousness in light of God's is filthy rags. Next comes the redemption—an angel of the Lord touches his lips with a live coal and says, Your iniquity is atoned for, your sins are purged. Next he hears the invitation (the gospel call). Whom shall I send? Whom shall go for Us? Isaiah having seen the vision of God, both seeing and hearing of His holiness and righteousness, having his very foundation upon which he stood shaken, experiencing the forgiveness and mercy of God, responds with the words, Here am I, send me! I'm here! I'm available! Are you? Paul writes, "present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." God hears His servant's plea and says, Go. So too, before we attempt any service for God, we also must have a revelation of God Himself and of ourselves, having our personal foundation shaken. Then listen for the call of God, and in kind, respond.

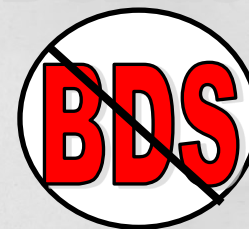
