

And the Lord turned and looked at Peter Then Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had said to him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times."

Poor Peter. Like Humpty Dumpty, he was headed for a great fall. Jesus, of course warned him of this but also gave him a word of encouragement as well. "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren." Pete, Satan's going to shake you up and rock your very foundation. You are going to fail, but your faith will not. You are going to leave me and forsake me but when (not if) you return to Me, I want you to strengthen the brethren. Be an encouragement to them. That is always a good ministry for all of us to be in—to encourage and strengthen the brethren. Be a Barnabas, a son of Encouragement. Notice also the grace and mercy of our Lord, he gave him a job to do. He did not sideline him or keep him in the dugout. He restored him and put him back in ministry. So often we think God is through with us after only one spiritual faceplant. No, a righteous man may fall seven times but notice he keeps getting up. That's grace. So too, God is always there to give you a hand up, not always a hand out. Notice also what Jesus did while Peter was in the midst of denying Him. He turned and looked at him. While He was busy being beaten up and interrogated, Jesus knew exactly where Peter was. He never lost sight. So too, God never loses sight of you even when your blowing it. He knows exactly where to turn and look and, with a gaze of compassion, restore you back to Himself without fail and sends you back out.
