Men are bottom line guys. We like information boiled down into simple terms. Solomon, in all his wisdom boiled the book of Ecclesiastes down to the simplest of terms: "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all" (Eccl 12:13). Paul said it even simpler: Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the Law (Rom. 13:10). Wow! No need to remember all 613 commandments in the Old Testament. All you need to remember are these two—love God supremely and go and love others as you love yourself. Notice how many times the term "all" is mentioned. How much is left over after all? Nothing. In Deuteronomy 10:12 He says, "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. There you have it. Walk in love, serve in love. Fear Him. After fulfilling the first commandment, we are to love others as we love ourselves. Do we need to learn to love ourselves first before we love others? Nope. We do that already. Our problem is we don't pass it on to others. That's the brass tax. Bottom line: Love God, love others. That's it.
