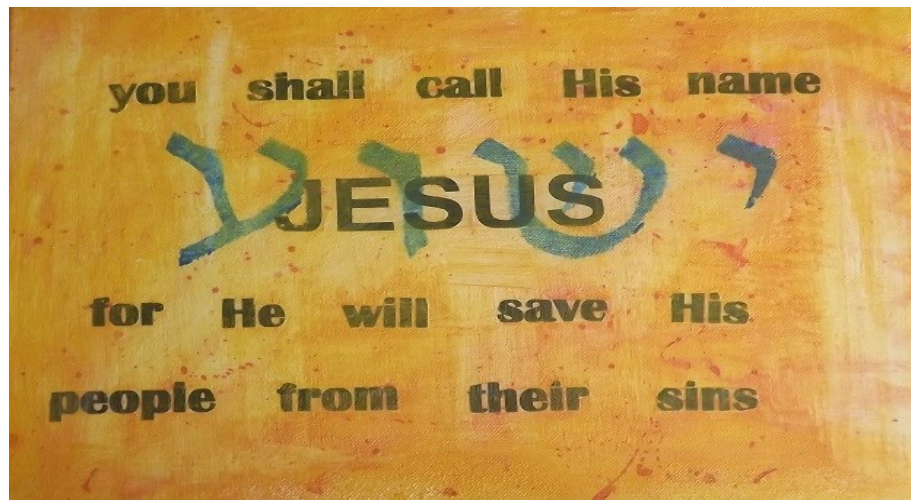


"Do not remember the former things, Nor consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing, Now it shall spring forth; Shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness *And* rivers in the desert. (Isaiah 43:18-19).

I can't wait. Can you? Jesus said, Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful." This coming New Year, remember that the God who loved you, redeemed you and made you His child has a lot more in store for you than you can imagine.
