Jesus said Come all you who labor and are heavy laden and I will give you rest. He who comes to me I will in no wise cast out. Our robes of self righteousness are like filthy rags compared to God's. In Christ He replaces them with robes of fine white linen. He gives us the ring of fellowship. He shods our feet with the preparation of the Gospel of peace by which we stand, as a sure foundation. The son was reconciled to the Father. So too, we are reconciled to the Father through Christ Jesus. We therefore implore you on Christ's behalf, be ye reconciled to God.
