

“Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name” (Hebrews 13:15).

The word, Praise, occurs over 200 times in the Bible with at least 40 specifically exhorting us to praise His Name. Names were very significant in the Bible. It’s interesting that the first job God gave to Adam was to give names to the animals. Names were used to signify a person’s origin or circumstance, purpose, a characteristic. For example, Adam means “ground” or “earth” as he came from the dust of the ground. You could say he was a real down to earth guy. Another example is Jacob, which means “heel-catcher” or “supplanter” signifying a circumstance at his birth. Eassau means “red” or “hairy”, another characteristic at his birth. Jacob’s name was changed to Israel, meaning man governed by God, prince. In Revelation, we are given the exciting revelation that each of us will be given a new name in Heaven by Jesus Himself (Rev. 2:17)! What does God’s name mean and what is its significance. God proclaimed His name to Moses and said, “The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing *the guilty*, That’s who He is and He never changes. He s the same yesterday, today and forever always merciful and gracious, longsuffering to us, abounding in goodness and truth. Praise the Name of the Lord, for He is good and His mercies fail not.

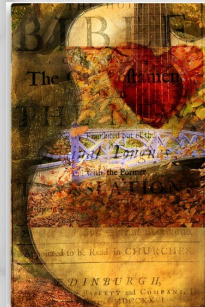
