"Do all things without murmuring and complaining (Philippians 2:14)

It is said that joy is the central theme of Philippians. Joy is mentioned four times in Philippians. The command to rejoice eight times. It is of course interesting where Paul was writing this epistle. He was in jail. Remember Paul and Silas in Philippi when Paul cast out the demon from the slave girl in Acts 16? They were rewarded by being thrown into prison, beaten, with their feet in stocks. Were they murmering and complaining? Nope. Instead they were praying and rejoicing, worshipping the Lord singing praise songs and the other prisoners were listening. Imagine that! What happened next is even more amazing. There was a great earthquake, foundations were shaken. prison doors were swung wide open and chains were loosed! When we respond to our earthquakes in the spirit of joy when our foundations are shaken, people take note, people listen, resulting in prison doors swinging wide, chains being loosed resulting in people getting saved.

"But certainly God has heard me; He has attended to the voice of my prayer. Blessed be God, Who has not turned away my prayer, nor His mercy from me" [Ps 66:19-2]!


