
And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!"

Wow! I'll bet the Apostles were not expecting this to happen. It was enough of a sensory overload to see Jesus transfigured before them. Now they just heard the voice of the Father. So profound was this experience that Peter refers back to it in his second epistle. "For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty. For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." And we heard this voice which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain. The Apostles were both eye and earwitnesses. John writes, That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life— (I John 1:1). They not only read the testimony of when the Israelites heard the voice on Mt. Sinai but now they themselves heard it with their own ears! Why did God the Father grace them to hear His voice? Peter earlier said, Let us make three Tabernacles, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah. All the prophets prophesied of Jesus. It was all about Jesus. He was the final revelation of God. God the Father reminded them, this is my Son. Hear Him! Mary in John 2 told the servants, Whatever He tells you to do, do it. Are you listening to Him?
